Class description: Join me for a day of Zen-inspired painting. With visual props of organic materials we will manipulate and build visual compositions, then interpret the inspiration to make neutral palette paintings. We will discuss and discover the properties of gesso and acrylic paint. Artists will create their own stencils as reusable tools, learn how to collage with painted layers, and practice markmaking to enhance the content.

Sticks and Stones supply list: students will need several paint brushes (round bristle brush recommended), spray bottle for water, container for water, an old cloth rag, a brayer, a pencil, scissors, and adhesive.

Instructor will provide: substrate, acrylic paint, gesso, and a packet of materials, fee: \$10.
